### **OPENING SENTENCES**

Psalm 118:24; Matthew 28:7; Hebrews 2:7; Psalm 8:6, adapted

- P: This is the day that the LORD has made:
- C: let us rejoice and be glad in it.
- P: Christ has risen from the dead. Alleluia!
- C: God the Father has crowned Him with glory and honor,
- P: He has given Him dominion over the works of His hands;
- C: He has put all things under His feet. Alleluia! Alleluia!

#### CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- P: Even on this festival day, if we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- C: But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:8-9

(Silence for reflection on God's Word and for self-examination.)

- P: Almighty God, heavenly Father,
- C: we confess that we have not remained strong in faith. We have not always let the sure news of Your Son's resurrection dispel the fear that wells up within us. We have thought, spoken, and acted in weakness. We have not loved You with our whole hearts, and we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We deserve Your judgment in time and eternity.

Forgive us and renew us in the sure and certain hope of our own resurrection day, when Job's righteous yearning, "I know that my Redeemer Lives" will no longer be a declaration of faith, but a longing fulfilled!

- P: By His suffering and death our Lord has paid for our sins, and by His rising has destroyed the power of death. As a called and ordained servant of our risen and triumphant Lord Jesus Christ and by His authority I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.

"Oh that my words were written!
Oh that they were inscribed in a book!
Oh that with an iron pen and lead
they were engraved in the rock forever!
For I know that my Redeemer lives,
and at the last he will stand upon the earth.
And after my skin has been thus destroyed,
yet in my flesh I shall see God.

P: This is the Word of the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God.

**EPISTLE** 1 Peter 1:3–9 (Born Again to a Living Hope)

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

**VERSE** 2 Timothy 1:10b

P: Alleluia. Christ Jesus abolished death

C: and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel. Alleluia.

**HOLY GOSPEL** Luke 24:1–8 (Jesus Christ is risen from the dead.)

P: The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the twenty-fourth chapter.

C: Glory to You, O Lord.

But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel. And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise." And they remembered his words.

P: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

C: Praise to You, O Christ.
