LENTEN THEME: Honest Repentance – "Purification" March 22, 2023

INVOCATION

P: In the name of the Father and of the 2 Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

PROMISE OF PURIFICATION Psalm 24:1–6; 66:12

L: Who shall ascend the hill of the LORD?

And who shall stand in his holy place?

C: He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to what is false and does not swear deceitfully.

L: He will receive blessing from the LORD and righteousness from the God of his salvation.

C: Such is the generation of those who seek him, who seek the face of the God of Jacob.

L: We went through fire and through water;

C: yet you have brought us out to a place of abundance.

CONFESSION (based on John 20: 24-29; Luke 24:36-43)

L: God promises blessing to those who have clean hands and a pure heart.

Knowing that our hands and our hearts are unclean and impure, we go before our Father in heaven and seek His forgiveness, knowing also that Jesus by His death on the cross has removed the contaminants of our sin once and for all.

(silent prayer)

L: Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you and worthily magnify your holy name, through Jesus Christ our Lord. C: Amen

- L: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. But if we confess our sins, God who is faithful and just will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- P: Most merciful God,
- C: we confess that we are in bondage to sin and cannot free ourselves. We have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with pure hearts: we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, purify us, and lead us, so that we may delight in your will and walk in your ways, to the glory of your holy name. Amen.
- L: Almighty God, in his mercy, has given his Son to die for us and, for his sake, forgives us all our sins so that in the fires of trial and temptation we will be purified and made holy for our dwelling place in heaven. In the name of the Father, and of the 2 Son, and of the Holy Spirit, we are forgiven.

EPISTLE Romans 12:1-2 (A Living Sacrifice)

I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

L: This is the Word of the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God!

HOLY GOSPEL John 11:55–57 (The Passover for purification)

L: The Holy Gospel according to St. John the 11th chapter.

C: Glory to You, O Lord.

Now the Passover of the Jews was at hand, and many went up from the country to Jerusalem before the Passover to purify themselves. They were looking for Jesus and saying to one another as they stood in the temple, "What do you think? That he will not come to the feast at all?" Now the chief priests and the Pharisees had given orders that if anyone knew where he was, he should let them know, so that they might arrest him.

L: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

C: Praise to You, O Christ.
