

OPENING SENTENCES John 15:5–9

- P: Jesus says to us all: I am the vine; you are the branches.
- C: Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.
- P: If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned.
- C: If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.
- P: By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.
